Footnotes

LET ME FINISH appeared to hit side of gate while breaking slow, was sent up along the rail, was trying to get out leaving the backstretch, shifted out in upper stretch, then surged from between foes and nailed leader late. KOPRITI was hustled to the front, set pressured pace from the inside, resisted inside rival in the drive, inched away late but could not hold off the winner in final strides. WARRENS TWO TO ONE angled out some early, was caught four wide into and around the turn, continued outside the winner in the drive and gained third. ANDY ONE angled over some while flashing early foot, prompted the pace into the bend, continued to force the issue outside pacesetter into the lane but yielded in the final sixteenth. MR. DAY TRIPPER washy in the post parade, bumped with rival early from between horses,stalked three wide into the lane, checked momentarily off the winner in upper stretch and lacked needed late punch. I WILL RISE forced the early pace from between horses, remained two wide, dropped back around the turn and weakened. ADDA STEP settled off the leaders, chased three wide into and around the bend and never menaced. ADMIRAL ROWAN reserved early, angled over, found the fence, remained inside and was never a threat. A claim of foul by the rider of MR. DAY TRIPPER against LET ME FINISH for alleged interference in the upper stretch was not allowed by the stewards who ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
