**Footnotes**

LONGHORN sprinted immediately to the fore, set all the fractions while well off the rail and was never threatened while being kept to task. A TOAST TO TANNER chased the winner from the start, angled out for the drive but could not reach the top one. AGREED AFFAIR raced in the middle of the pack for a half mile, bid three wide through the final turn, dropped inside for the drive and show some late response without impacting the outcome. CADRE NOIRE was close up from the start, could not gain ground and closed evenly. BORN TO COMMAND lagged to the final turn, swung out and then had little late response. FORBIDDEN FIGHT raced in the middle of the pack and did not rally. SUNSET KID was away slowly, raced far back to the stretch and showed some late interest without menacing. KASH'S KOMET raced evenly and did not reach contention. J. SANTOS attended the pace for a half mile, then checked hard along the rail entering the turn to lose all momentum and chance. SKIMMING'S FIRST was pulled up near the quarter pole and walked off.
