Footnotes

DAYLIGHT MAGIC exchanged bumps with inside rival early, moved up and engaged pacesetter on the turn, battled outside that rival, gained advantage passing sixteenth marker and edged away. VITAMEATAVEGAMIN broke alertly and quickly stepped to the front while crossing over, resisted from the inside on the turn and well into the stretch but could not go with winner late. D'WILDBUNCH tracked the pace from between horses, continued three wide into and around the bend, came in bit and was clearly best of the rest. MY ROYAL KNIGHT bumped repeatedly with outside rival early, stalked from the inside, lugged out leaving the backstretch, lost contact, then came in and was no late factor. PROMETHEUS BULL between horses and four wide early, also lugged out entering the turn then steadied sharply off heels of MY ROYAL KNIGHT and never recovered. ACE HIGH FLUSH was slow into stride, chased throughout from along the rail and never threatened. MR SUPERSTITION caught outside then four deep nearing the turn, bore out into and around the bend and lacked any rally.
