CHINESE PRAISE chased inside a rival down the backstretch, angled to the rail on the second turn, bid for the lead at the top of the stretch, took command and drew out in the final furlong. TALES OF TIGGER drifted wide around the first turn, chased from the back down the backstretch, came out into the stretch and rallied to gain the place. EDGEWICK ROAD chased on the inside throughout and improved his position in the final furlong. YOU BETTOR BEWARE pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch, was between horses entering the second turn and weakened in the drive. OMINOUS THOMAS chased outside the winner down the backstretch, moved closer on the second turn to bid for the lead, was floated out and bumped by the pacesetter at the top of the stretch and weakened thereafter. POLLY'S DANCER crossed over to take the lead into the first turn, maintained the advantage to the second turn, drifted out at the top of the lane to bump a rival and fell back through the final furlong.
