Footnotes

PRIMAL DESIRE was caught three deep around the first turn, pressed the pace past the stands the first time around, took over the lead on the backstretch, drew clear and widened her advantage in the lane. UNUSUAL DARLING saved ground around the first turn, chased inside a rival into the second turn, angled off the inside midway down the backstretch, was no threat to the winner but was a clear second. MILE HIGH BUNK was restrained going into the first turn, pulled between horses in the stretch the first time around, stalked outside a rival into the second turn and was unable to threaten in the drive. KALOOKAN DESERT was between horses around the first turn and inside a rival into the second turn, saved ground around the third turn and lacked the necessary rally. MOBETTERMOBETTER sped to a clear lead on the inside around the first turn, dueled on the inside around the second turn, could not keep pace with the winner on the backstretch and gave way. MISS PURPLE RAIN pulled around the first turn, came into the stretch the first time three wide, chased outside a rival around the second turn, chased on the outside down the backstretch and gave way.
