**Footnotes**

FIRST TIME JOHN rushed up from the outside and grabbed lead entering the bend, quickly kicked clear while crossing over, grew bit leg weary from the inside late and lasted. DEVGRU broke alertly and forced the early pace, lost contact while drifting three wide into the stretch, then re-rallied and whittled gap on winner late. EPIC RULE bumped with outside rival in opening strides, stalked while off rail then outside foe, remained bit off the rail and held third. DIRTY DEED bumped at the start, forced the pace from between horses, dropped back three then four wide into the lane and lacked needed rally. MINISTER MACHINE settled well off the rail, chased outside foe, remained three wide on the turn, came out further and failed to threaten. CONGRATS SKI lagged back from the inside, saved ground but was outrun.
