Footnotes

FOLK DANCER lightly bumped leaving the gate then quickly stepped to the front, was deftly rated from along the rail, roused around final turn and drew off while kept to task. CARRIE ROSE was slow to begin, tugging early from the inside, settled, later shifted out, raced three wide around the last turn and picked up the place. COLLATING LADY broke out and bumped winner, settled inside, saved ground early, later angled out, chased three wide around the last bend, came out further in the lane and gained third. INNER GROOVE moved up to pressure pacesetter into second turn, continued bit off the rail, dropped back and weakened. LAST STING settled off the rail, chased three wide early then slightly off the rail, gained the rail passing the quarter marker but never menaced. CONJURE THE SPIRIT reserved around initial turn, raced three wide, came in slightly later and also weakened. GITTEL stumbled to her nose leaving the gate, quickly recovered and moved up to stalking position three wide, remained wide but dropped back readily in the final quarter.
