**Footnotes**

MY SUMMER SLEW forced the pace from off the into backstretch, continued to pressure the pacesetter into the lane, moved alongside, battled in drive then wore down rival late. HIGH STANDARDS quickly stepped to the front, set pressured pace along the rail, asked for more run into and around second bend, dug in when challenged but gave ground grudgingly nearing the wire. LUCKY HONEY settled outside rival, secured the inside and whittled gap on leaders on second turn, angled out and finished evenly. STEADY DEMAND prominently placed from off the rail early, chased three wide, came four wide into the lane and failed to menace. RIVER ECHO lagged back while bit off the rail, chased two wide, came out in upper stretch and was no threat. LASER POINT angled in early, chased from along the rail, remained inside and weakened.
