REALLY UPTOWN caught four deep contesting the pace into initial turn, continued on same path into backstretch, angled in bit then bid outside rival into second turn, gained lead then kicked clear and safely held under moderate hand pressure. FIRE IN THE WIND forced the early issue from between rivals and three deep, remained on same path, dropped back some into second bend, continued three wide into the lane and finished strongly under vigorous handling. BERTRAN HILL hopped leaving the gate but quickly recovered and flashed speed inside, dueled then gained slim lead along the rail into backstretch, relinquished control on second bend and held for the show. SOUTHERN VICTORY lugged inward early then was forced out into first turn, settled outside rival, later gained the rail and just missed third. LONGONAGUSKA broke in bit, prompted the pace from between foes and two wide, dropped back into the final bend and weakened. FARMER GILES (IRE) drifted out into first bend, settled inside, saved ground chasing leaders and lacked any response late.
