ZETTERBERG reserved from off the rail, made steady progress four wide into and around second turn, engaged leaders three deep through the drive and gamely got up from the outside in final strides. SAVVY AND SMOOTH angled over the stalked into backstretch, moved up and dueled outside pacesetter, edged away on the final turn, resisted from the inside, battled gamely through prolonged drive and narrowly missed. TOMMYS LUCK crossed over and stalked leaders to second turn, advanced three wide into the stretch, challenged outside foe then battled from between rivals in final sixteenth and was denied. ELUSIVE SCHEMES settled inside, saved ground to the second bend, swung out exiting that turn and finished very willingly. RIVERGRADE BOY was slow to begin, chased on three wide path around both bends, shifted in late and finished with interest. SUPERFECTA settled outside foe, chased on two wide path into the stretch and failed to menace. AFLEET'S DESIGN was off alertly and sprinted to the front while securing the rail, dueled briefly inside runner-up, remained inside and weakened. RICHER GEAR settled inside, remained along the rail and was outrun throughout.
