**Footnotes**

SAX three wide early, continued off the rail, whittled gap on leaders then surged to front nearing the stretch, quickly opened gap, came in some under urging, grew weary late and just lasted. BRAVE JUSTICE angled over early, shifted back out entering the backstretch, made steady progress on three wide path into the stretch, closed strongly on leader late but just ran out of ground. NO CAPS NO FLOORS was off bit slow and settled along the rail, angled out leaving first turn, rushed up from outside to grab command, edged away, had little resistance for winner entering the lane and safely held third. ECHO WEST was bit antsy in the gate, forced the early pace from the inside, dropped back, came three wide into the lane and finished evenly. DIXIE RAIDER drifted out into first turn, angled back in some, chased while bit off the rail and lacked any rally. DEFENSE KING reserved along the rail, saved ground throughout but was no factor. UBETIMFAST flashed good early foot along the rail, relinquished control on the backstretch and faded.
