Footnotes

TREVOR'S CLEVER unhurried leaving the gate, bit off the fence entering backstretch, made steady progress, looped leaders while three then four wide into the stretch, reached front passing sixteenth marker and edged away. SAGAPONACK reserved early, made steady progress while three wide then inside winner around the final turn, continued on same path but was outfinished. SCOTT'S SPIRIT stalked on two wide path into backstretch, moved up and loomed from between rivals but failed to sustain effort late. ALL PRO pressured the pacesetter early, continued outside leader, gained lead then edged away into the stretch but could hold off rivals in drive. BEAU SMOKE settled inside, moved up some along the rail into second turn but weakened late. CONVENIENT MARQUET angled over early, secured the inside, saved ground thereafter and lacked any rally. GOTTHATFEELING quickly stepped to the front, set the pace inside, lost command on second turn, gave way readily inside in final eighth then returned bleeding in the nostrils.
