FORTUNATE APPEAL dueled inside rival into the first turn, gained upper hand on the backstretch, padded that cushion into the lane, and extended margin under urging. WARREN'S TOMMY TOO tracked the leading pair around the first turn, continued inside to the stretch, could not threaten winner in the drive but held the place. MY LAST TYCOON settled while bit off the rail, remained well off the fence, roused and moved up three wide on the final bend and closed gap on runner-up late. PADRE JON chased three wide then outside foe into backstretch, remained on same path and lacked any late response. BRANDONSHIGHHONORS contested the early pace outside winner then forced pace into the backstretch, dropped back into second turn and faded. SWONGS was off bit slow, crossed over while unhurried, chased from the inside throughout and gave way in the stretch.
