Footnotes

TASTE OF JOY settled outside rival, angled over, advanced along the rail around the turn, came out slightly into the lane, swerved inward to fallen rider then rallied inside and drew clear. SINGLE IN MAY forced the early issue from the inside, came out some, between horses then three wide into the stretch and held the place. BENSANNA stalked from the outside then three wide on the turn, was floated four wide into the lane and gained third. FOREVER PATIENT settled inside, moved up from the inside around the turn, drifted out some leaving the turn, forced to jump over fallen horse passing eighth marker, inherited brief lead then yielded in the drive. CARLA DORADA was slow to begin and dropped back early, saved ground and was outrun. CHI WAA WAA LADY grabbed early lead then crossed over, stretched that cushion around the turn but broke down in the upper stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident in the stretch but did not make a change.
