Footnotes

MELISSA ROSE raced three wide into and around the first turn, moved up on the outside down the backstretch, took command entering the second turn and drew out through the lane. SI MAR'S DEAR went around the first turn inside a rival, chased on the wood down the backstretch, came into the stretch between horses, angled inside in the final furlong and was up for the place on the wire. DIAMOND JOURNEY chased off the rail around the first turn and outside a rival down the backstretch, was caught three deep around the second turn, came into the stretch three wide and was edged for the place at the wire. DESPERATE MEASURES was angled outside the pacesetter into the first turn, pressed the pace down the backstretch, tried to keep pace with the winner on the second turn and weakened between horses in the final furlong. RACHEL JONES raced three deep around the first turn, chased inside a foe down the backstretch, saved some ground around the second and did not offer a rally. NOISE OF THE CROWD sped to the lead and crossed over into the first turn, showed the way down the backstretch, relinquished command entering the second turn and fell back through the lane.
