DEE DEE'S DINER drifted in at the gap, chased inside, came out leaving the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under some urging to prove best. MEMOGRAM sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the inside, came out into the stretch and could not hold off the winner. HIGHLY ARROGANT saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, angled back in and bested the others. WHY KNOTT ME TOO crowded early, settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the first turn then came out again on the backstretch and failed to menace. AMA RAY stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. GENERAL EXPRESSION rank stalking the early pace outside a rival, continued close up off the rail then outside a foe into the second turn, steadied between horses into the stretch and weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of WHY KNOTT ME TOO against the winner for alleged interference in the early staged was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the minor incident did not alter the original order of finish.
