Footnotes

SONORA DANCER stalked the leaders while bit off the rail into backstretch, moved up, continued rally three wide into the stretch, overhauled pacesetter and edged away under urging. KLEVEN'S VERBATIM stepped to the front, carved out fractions from the inside, continued just off the rail but could not stave off winner late. HAVE CONFIDENCE forced the early issue outside pacesetter, continued two wide, later angled to the rail and weakened. DA SVEDONYA reserved from the inside, saved ground to second turn, came out, split foes and improved placing. SPY ALY chased the pace while saving ground, angled out into the stretch but was no serious factor. TEN CARAT SLEW checked in the early stages, reserved while a bit off the rail and outrun. KEPT PROMISE drifted out into the first turn, came back in some, chased outside rival and never reached contention. CHARLIES DOT lugged out into and around the first turn, remained very wide into the backstretch, continued well off the fence and never recovered. K GIRL was carried out into the first turn, angled angled in the secured the rail but was no factor.
