TRAFFIC UPDATE content to track the pacesetter while outside that rival, rushed up and quickly surged to the front into the lane and kicked clear while ridden out. SMUDGELEDO bobbled slightly leaving the gate but quickly recovered and stepped to the front, dictated the pace from along the rail, had little resistance for the winner but comfortably held second. FAVORITE MEETING caught four wide into first turn, chased from off the rail then three wide exiting last bend and reeled in rival late for minor award. GET OFF THE SUGAR settled five wide into the first turn, angled in some, stalked outside rival, remained on same path and lost the show. ROCKY JOE reserved from the inside, saved ground throughout but to no avail. NORTH AMERICA unhurried from the inside, regained the rail in the stretch and failed to reach contention. AEROJACK broke out, settled three wide, chased from between foes or off the rail and was outrun. HENRY D. angled in and secured the inside, stalked the pace from along the rail, dropped back and weakened. FIRST SYMPHONY four wide into first turn, remained bit wide throughout and failed to make any late impact.
