WARREN'S PEPE quickly stepped to the front, rated from slightly off the fence then along the rail, assumed clear cushion leaving second bend, resisted when challenged in final turn then stubbornly held from along the rail. LOW GEAR POWER unhurried from the inside early, angled out, rushed up from the outside, engaged the leader into final turn, drifted out some entering the lane then lugged out nearing the wire and narrowly missed. SIDEPOCKET LOU reserved from off the rail, chased three wide most of the way into the stretch then rallied gamely for third. DESERT COWBOY angled in early, chased from the inside, later came off the fence, between foes then two wide into the lane and was outfinished for third. ROYAL VISION settled inside, chased from along the rail, saved ground and failed to menace. PREMIERE FLYER was pulling hard early from the inside then in bit tight off heels with lap left, came off the fence exiting the last turn and was no factor. PLENTY JADE stalked or prompted the pace outside leader to second turn, took apparent bad step and was pulled up leaving that bend and vanned off.
