Footnotes

TURNAGAIN TAYLOR was quickest from the gate and crossed over, dictated all the pace, rebuffed rival in upper stretch and held while coming out bit late. FRIENDLY HALF bobbled in the opening stride but quickly recovered, stalked outside foe, loomed outside winner in upper stretch then finished evenly. BIG SWISS settled off the pace, chased four then three wide into the stretch and edged away from rival late for third. JUST FOR US chased three wide then between foes, came in bit and finished evenly. POWER TOOL stalked early from the inside, hugged the rail throughout but weakened. ELEGANT CAD between rivals early, was bit erratic on two wide path into the turn, dropped back and weakened. IM PURE COUNTRY reserved early, chased five wide, came in bit and lacked any response. THE ROCKET was four wide early, angled in some, chased outside foe and failed to make any late impact.
