Footnotes

WARREN'S DR. BOO quickly sped to the front, accelerated away around the turn while bit off the fence and left foes in his wake while still off the rail and under right hand asking until final yards. MR. CAPPUCCINO chased from off the rail, continued three then four wide into the stretch and outfought inside rival for the place. PRINCE BANDINI reserved from the inside, continued two then three wide to the stretch, came out slightly in the drive and was outfinished for the place. VALEN chased three into the bend, angled out bit, was fanned six wide and outside MINISTER EXPRESS departing the turn, remained outside and failed to threaten. LATIN COFFEE settled outside, gradually shifted over nearing the turn, chased two wide on the turn, then three wide into the lane, was blocked in upper stretch, found clear path later but failed to menace. MINISTER EXPRESS showed good early foot, lost contact early on the turn, came out some then raced five wide into the stretch and weakened. CONTRIBUTED was bit slow to begin, rushed up along the rail prompted the early pace then came off the fence a bit and weakened. CLEVER CONCEPT hesitated to be off behind the field, lagged back then was taken to the rail, continued inside thereafter and was outrun.
