Footnotes

DRAMATICAT was pressured on lead early, dictated the pace from bit off the rail, padded cushion around the final bend and clearly prevailed from off the rail under right hand urging. CANAL GRANDE broke out then settled well off the pace while angling over some, chased four wide into second turn, came in slightly entering the stretch and found his best stride late. MR. NIGHT FEVER forced the early issue then caught four wide into first turn, stalked from the outside, came in some then two wide exiting the last turn and yielded some from the inside. SALTY ROBBIN chased early from along the rail, shifted out passing three-eighths marker, followed runner-ups path into the stretch, came in slightly late and was no threat. PHILLY SLEW hopped slightly in a slow start, trailed from the inside, remained along the rail throughout and only passed tiring rivals. PRINCETHEFIFTH forced the pace while outside rival around first turn, stalked along the rail then dropped back and weakened. COLD SILENCE pressed the early issue while three wide on run into first turn, stalked from off the rail, also dropped back and weakened. SCOOTER'S STAR prominently placed from the inside early, remained along the rail, retreated on the backstretch and gave way readily.
