WARREN'S WHISTLE angled in and saved ground off the pace, went around a rival leaving the second turn and rallied inside under urging through the stretch to gamely prevail. ALWAYS THE LADY a half step slow into stride, sped to the early lead, dueled a bit off the rail, inched away in the stretch, fought back outside the winner but could not quite match that one late. CINNFUL BRIDE stalked the pace outside, bid three deep into the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. HARVEST GIRL vied for command between horses then outside the runner-up to the stretch and weakened. SONG OF SUMMER in a bit tight and forced wide on the first turn, settled outside, went three deep on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. PROUD TAMMIE dueled between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, angled in on the second turn and weakened. MISS SANTA ANA blew the first turn, chased outside then alongside a rival and did not rally. FILIGREE forced wide and steadied on the first turn, trailed off the rail and was outrun.
