### Footnotes

SIBERIAN HEART stalked off the rail then three wide, moved up and gained command nearing final turn, edged away through the drive and safely held. VIVACIOUS ANNA chased three or four lane and between foes, made some progress nearing second turn, shifted out entering that bend, rallied wide into the lane, was forced to steady and forced out nearing the sixteenth marker, recovered and rallied for the place. SHESKEY between foes stalking the pace, moved up and loomed into the final turn, continued three wide, veered out under left hand pressure in the drive, angled back in and lost the place. OBVIOUS CHOICE was sent to the front and controlled the pace from along the rail, could not go with winner in final turn and weakened some from the inside. SLEEPY TIME GIRL was slow to begin and reserved from along the rail, saved ground to final turn, shifted out and improved placing. FIFTY K caught four wide early then chased three wide, angled to the rail in the stretch and weakened. JAN THE FIRST drifted out some around the initial turn, came back in some, chased three wide and never threatened. SERENE SERENA settled inside, moved up some along the rail into second turn but later weakened. FATAL EDGE caught five wide on the first turn, angled back in, lagged back and failed to reach contention. BOOKDMYOCEANCRUISE forced the pace while three deep early, dropped back and steadily gave way late inside.
