Footnotes

MOVE OVER angled outside the pacesetter past the stands the first time around, pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch, took command leaving the three sixteenths pole, drew out through the lane while drifting out a bit and was under a long hold late. LAST EQUITY pulled between horses around the first turn, chased off the rail down the backstretch, saved some ground around the second turn, came out for the stretch drive, could not threaten the winner but was clearly second best. HARLAN'S HALO pulled while being caught three deep around the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail down the backstretch, kept to his task and gained the show in the final strides. DOWNTOWN JOE sped to the early lead, was taken in hand passing the finish line the first time around, set the pace on the inside to the second turn, weakened on the rail through the final furlong and was edged for the show on the wire. CUATRERO saved ground around the first turn, chased on the inside and did not mount a rally. FIRST EXPLOSION saved ground around the first turn, chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch and did not threaten.
