Footnotes

JERRY'S FEVER forwardly placed into first turn, whittled gap on pacesetter and gained lead passing quarter marker, quickly kicked clear on last turn, continued bit off the rail, repulsed inside rival in the drive and inched away late. NARANJO settled outside rival, advanced two wide then along the rail, regained the rail departing the second turn, nearly reached even terms with winner approaching sixteenth marker but gave ground grudgingly late. HAPPY TOGETHER settled along the rail, angled out and moved up three then four wide into the stretch, lugged out under left hand pressure in the lane and finished determinedly outside. BIG G'S DANCE was taken off the leaders early, chased three wide around both turns, came in slightly in the stretch and weakened. MY DARK VADA tracked pace from the inside, came out slightly, continued two wide around the last turn and failed to menace. WALKS LIKE BRANDO flashed keen early foot and sped clear, was overtaken just before the quarter marker, dropped back then checked off heels into the stretch and gave way.
