Footnotes

LAMM three wide early while tugging, continued to track pacesetter from off the rail, moved up leaving third turn, challenged then dueled outside that rival, gained lead, kicked clear and safely held under urging. JOE CARL reserved from off the fence, caught four wide early then five wide departing the second turn, remained outside, moved up around the final bend, came in slightly and was along for second. BIG SON OF A GUN between rivals early, remained either two or three wide chasing the pace, remained off the rail and rallied late to gain minor award. ROYAL ENCOUNTER settled off the rail, tracked the leaders while either three or four wide, remained bit wide entering the stretch and lacked needed late punch. ROCK THIS WAY stepped to the front, rated from along the rail through leisurely fractions, resisted when challenged on the final backstretch, battled into the last turn, lost contact with leader and weakened inside. FALLING KNIFE bumped leaving the gate, unhurried from the inside, saved ground while content to lag back, came out bit in the later stages but never menaced. LODI RED between rivals through the opening late, continued on same path, moved up bit approaching the last turn then failed to sustain effort and weakened. LIBERTY CAP bumped at the start, settled along the inside, hugged the rail through first lap, saved ground throughout and faded. HASTY TREND pulled his way into stalking position early from the inside, tracked leader through opening two turns, then dropped back, gave way readily, was eased in the stretch and walked off.
