MOORE'S FLAT stalked outside a rival early, went up three deep into the second turn, tracked outside a foe on the backstretch, bid outside SKY JACK nearing the second turn, took a short lead into the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. SKY JACK floated out on the first turn while vying for the lead, dueled outside a rival then between foes into the second turn, inched away and angle in between calls early on the backstretch, fought back inside the winner on the second turn and through the stretch but could not quite match that one late. DIG FOR IT settled off the inside, was no threat to the top pair but picked up the show. IT'S A REALITY sent inside early, drifted out off the rail under a hold on the first turn while dueling for the lead, angled back in and vied for command along the inside, dropped back on the backstretch and weakened.
