MIMI'S CAFE content to settle from along the rail, advanced down the final backstretch, angled out, split foes around the last bend, then regained the fence and overhauled rival under strong right hand pressure. REVILLEW SLEW angled in some and chased the leader through the opening half, steadily reeled in pacesetter and challenged outside foe late on final backstretch, surged to the front, remained off the fence and dug in bravely but could not stave off winner. WARREN'S WHISTLE hopped slightly at the start, reserved while a bit wide, commenced rally approaching the last bend, was caught four wide around turn and finished strongly from the outside. GRACE AVENUE lagged back from the inside early, angled out and advanced steadily, slit foes on the final turn and finished willingly. SHE'S A SENSATION settled off the pace and a bit wide, never seriously menaced and only passed tiring foes. GARDEN IN THE RAIN (FR) chased outside rival early, continued on three wide path and weakened. GLEEFULLY saved ground throughout and failed to make any late impact. SOUTHERN HOUSE (IRE) was quickest into stride and controlled the pace from just off the fence, gave little resistance when challenged nearing the final bend and gave way readily.
