**Footnotes**

GRANJA VIVO set or forced the pace from along the rail, gained a slim lead entering the stretch and desperately held under strong urging. ICEE CHEASPEAKE broke out, settled outside rival, caught three wide into the final turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed stoutly from outside and just ran out of ground. GO GAL GO forced the early issue outside foe, later gained slim lead on backstretch, continued very prominent into the lane but gave ground grudgingly late. BUTTERTART reserved off the leaders while securing the rail, rallied from along the inside and improved placing. ACLEVERSHADEOFJADE stalked along the rail early, angled out, raced outside foe on second turn, then three wide into the lane and weakened. STAGE DOWN was off very tardily, lagged well back from along he rail, saved ground and only passed tiring rivals. APOLLO'S MUSIC unhurried from well off the rail, split foes into the stretch, drifted out late and was never a factor. PLUS THREE checked off heels leaving the chute, raced close up from between foes and but had little left for the stretch. CANTALOUPE hopped st the start, chased three deep into and around the first turn, remained wide and tired.
