SPARK OF DUBAI confidently stalked the pace from the start, responded quickly when given a couple of taps of the whip after three quarters of a mile, blew by the leaders and was geared down at the end. AWESOME GAMBLER lagged in the early going, split rivals early in the final turn and gamely split another pair in the mid stretch while being pushed in and continued to close well to be up for the place without menacing the top one. HURRY UP AUSTIN chased the leaders from the start and closed evenly. SCOONERWHARFBARDOG never far back, could not reach contention, then had little late response when more was needed. PREFERRED YIELD challenged the pace after a half mile, then had nothing left. LONGHORN showed little. LARRY BY THE LAKE sprinted to the front before the first turn, set all the pace for three quarters of a mile, began weakening along the rail, was forced to check hard at mid stretch and lost all chance. CONGO LOUIE was taken in hand soon after the start and was always last.
