SWEET BELLE pressed the pace to the stretch, came to even terms turning for home but the could not match strides with the winner in the late going. LOGAN AVENUE LINDA tracked the leaders from the outside, bid three wide through the final turn and closed evenly. VELVET MOONLITE sprinted up inside to set all the pace for three quarters of a mile and began weakening late in the final turn. WATCH ME WIN raced in the middle of the pack throughout and closed evenly. DONA AMELIA (CHI) did not reach contention. QUICK LITTLE MISS was never a factor. FORTUNATE EVENT was outrun.
