### Footnotes

LEMON CHIFFON content to settle off the pace and off the rail, chased three then four wide through opening half, rushed up when turned loose midway on the final backstretch, surged to the front, accelerated away and convincingly scored while under mild hand urging and only shown stick late. SWISS CURRENT reserved while angling over, chased between and two wide, came out some around the final turn, caught four wide entering the stretch and gamely rallied for the place. DONA AMELIA (CHI) patiently handled while between foes then securing the rail, shifted off entering the final bend, caught four then five wide into the lane and closed strongly from the far outside. VANGUARDA (ARG) settled three wide, came in some and chased from between foes, remained off the rail and improved placing late. ACCOPELA CHOIR unhurried from the inside, later came off the fence, chased three wide into and around the final bend and lacked needed late punch. WICKEDNWACKYINGRID quickly assumed control, set early pace while slightly off the rail, collared then forced pace outside rival, poker her nose in front very briefly from between foes then had no answer for the winner and weakened in drive. HAWAIIAN AFLEET angled over shortly off the break, gained the rail, moved up and gained slim lead with a lap left, was collared on final backstretch then faded. AUNT PINK stalked dueling leaders from bit off the rail, continued on three wide path, was in bit tight from between rivals into the last turn then gave way.
