Footnotes

YES HE'S A PISTOL was bit reluctant to load, crossed over approaching first turn, chased from along the fence, moved into and around second bend, came off the rail, reeled in leader and pulled clear. SEMPAL flashed keen early foot while angling over, controlled the pace from the inside, retained cushion into the stretch but could stave off winner. WORLD WAR between foes early then caught three wide, chased from outside the winner into and around the final turn and finished willingly. RIBOMOON was bit tight early, chased three wide around both turns and improved placing late. CARIBBEAN BOY unhurried while angling over, raced outside foe and two wide to second bend, swung out leaving that turn and failed to threaten. SCOONERWHARFBARDOG settled inside, hugged the rail throughout and was never a serious factor. GAINING PROSPERITY drifted out bit into first turn, recovered and forced the pace into the backstretch, lost contact with pacesetter on second bend, drifted out again and weakened. CURICO four wide into the first turn, chased from off the rail and three wide leaving backstretch and was outrun. GOOSIE GOOSIE slightly off the rail early, dropped back around the first turn, then was pulled up and vanned off.
