Footnotes

ANABAA PREMIUM broke in and bumped rival, forced the early pace then moved up and gained lead leaving second turn, resisted inside rival around the last turn and into stretch, inched away late in the drive and held. WON WON OH FIVE gained stalking position with one lap remaining, moved out around the middle turn, challenged outside leader, battled around the final turn and through the stretch but was turned back. LITE THAT BABY UP settled along the

rail, came out some, advanced three then four wide into the final turn, came three wide into the stretch and gamely held for third. TIZ DYNAMIC was hard to load then bobbled leaving the gate, chased off the rail then four wide, was steered to the rail, moved up, lacked room along the rail nearing last bend, continued inside and lost bob for the show. GOOD LUCK REDD chased either two wide or between horses, continued bit off the rail, swung out four wide into the stretch and closed belatedly from the outside. EVERLASTING MAN was bumped from both sides at the start, pulling early from the inside, came out leaving second turn, made middle move from off the rail but failed to sustain effort. DENNY THE GREAT broke out and slammed into outside rival then steadied shortly after the start, chased off the rail then three wide, dropped back and weakened. OAK TREE DRIVE was bumped hard leaving the gate, recovered and forced the early issue while three wide, dropped back on the final backstretch and also weakened. EXTRA HOT was bumped at the break, reserved inside, saved ground throughout but faded in the late going. SAXON ROYALTY close up early from between horses, stalked three wide, later came in and gained the rail, dropped back readily in the final three furlongs, was eased in the stretch and walked off. SEDONA RIDGE stepped to the front, set pace from along the rail, relinquished the lead on the second turn then gave way readily, was also eased in the stretch and walked off.
