Footnotes

KINDLE broke out at the start, quickly crossed over to take the lead into the first turn, drifted out some around the turn, opened up a clear advantage down the backstretch and into the stretch, remained well clear through the final furlong under steady urging. GREAT HOT (BRZ) was unhurried in the early going, drifted out around the first turn, chased off the rail, came into the stretch four wide, rallied four deep in the final furlong and gained the place. ALL ON THE TABLE chased off the rail around the first turn and down the backstretch, came into the lane three wide, rallied three deep in the final furlong and gained the show. BLUSHING MARTHA drifted out around the first turn, chased on the outside down the backstretch, was between horses in mid-stretch and weakened in the final furlong. NINTH INFANTRY angled inside the winner around the first turn, chased that foe in the clear down the backstretch and around the second turn, and weakened on the inside through the final furlong. CANDREA saved ground around the first turn, angled off the rail down the backstretch then back in approaching the second turn, saved ground around that turn but failed to threaten.
