PRETTY 'N SMART stalked the early pace from between foes, rushed up three wide to take the lead on the second turn, opened up a clear advantage into the stretch and held that margin to the wire. HEAVEN CAME DOWN dueled for the lead outside a rival, could not match strides with the winner in the late going but held gamely for the place. CHASTITY BELLE broke sharply and was allowed to settle into stride along the rail, angled out in mid stretch and finished full of run. WAVEBAND was away alertly and unhurried, raced outside a rival on the first turn, angled to the rail on the backstretch and showed good late interest. GRAZIE PAPA vied for the lead along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. SYLVAN GIRL (IRE) void of early foot along the rail, fanned four wide into the lane and failed to threaten. SPANISH BEAM showed no early speed, angled over to the rail shortly after the start and was always outrun. MAGICAL GIFT raced three wide into the first turn while stalking the pace, angled over to the rail into the second turn and faded.
