Footnotes

SILVER HAWK LADY hustled from the start, found her best stride entering the backstretch, came to even terms with the leaders after a half mile, responded three wide through the final turn, dug in for the drive and was able to hold off the late closing BUTTERFLY BELLE. BUTTERFLY BELLE was awkward into stride, lagged for a half mile, asked three wide through the second turn, loomed menacingly on the outside entering the drive but could not reach the front. LIPS LIKE SUGAR sped to duel with MISS HIGH BROW to the quarter pole, assumed a short lead and then could not match strides the rest of the way but held the show. GIN N' TYCHONIC edged up on the leaders through the backstretch, came three wide through the final turn and closed evenly. MISS BUONA SERA raced wide through both turns, and while she could not reach contention, showed some late interest. MISS HIGH BROW sprinted forward to duel to the backstretch and then dropped out after a half mile. TOMENCINO chased the pace to the backstretch and dropped back quickly. LET'S GO TO TOWN was never a factor.
