BAND OF THUNDER close up early from the inside, dropped back bit then re-rallied and surged inside CAPT. JOE BLOW to grab command and steadily padded lead under urging. CAPT. JOE BLOW flashed good early foot, set the pace from slightly off the rail, had little resistance for winner into the final bend then chased that one to the wire. SUNSHINE RIDGE settled off the rail, gradually angled over to secure the inside, rallied and proved much the best of the rest. I'LL TRY unhurried from the inside, continued along the rail throughout and gained minor award. GIOVANNI (NZ) chased while bit wide into the around first turn, moved up to force pace, dropped back while three wide and weakened. YES TALK TO ME settled inside, came out and chased from between rivals and weakened. STEADY DEMAND was off a bit slow, rushed up between, chased off the rail then three wide then faded.
