ISLAND SUNSET stepped to the front, set pressured pace into first turn, steadily pulled away and aggressively handled well into the stretch before before geared down only late. COUNTRY IMPACT broke out and bumped outside rival, settled three wide then outside rival, saved ground into stretch, shifted out and was along for second. LITTLE TRAVIS prominently placed early from along the rail, stalked from the inside to the stretch, came out some and gained third. QUIETLY WAITING settled early, moved up some into backstretch, outside rival to second turn, came in bit in the stretch and was outfinished for third. OUR JUKE BOX HERO reserved from off the rail, raced on two wide path to second turn and improved placing late. SOUTHOFTHEQUATOR was bumped and forced out at the start, recovered and pressured the pacesetter into first turn, lost contact, gained the inside and faded in final eighth. PAT'S BLUE RIBBON unhurried leaving the chute, drifted out into first turn, continued off the rail and lacked any response. SMOKIN MOJO reserved from the inside, saved ground into the stretch and was outrun throughout.
