Footnotes

FORT WILLIAM broke out then forced the early pace, moved up alongside pacesetter on the second turn, quickly disposed of that rival exiting that bend and drew off under steady handling. TOP TORERO broke alertly and sped to the front, set pressured pace to the second turn, briefly resisted inside winner but dropped back in the lane and comfortably held second. MOONLIGHT BEACH close up early from along the rail, tracked the top pair to the second turn, lost contact but saved the show. EXPENSIVE PENS drifted out into first turn, continued off the rail then three wide around the final turn and closed gap on third place rival late. ADDA STEP was slow into stride, lagged well back into backstretch, saved ground but was never a late threat. IAMMAKINGAPOINT settled between horses, came in bit, saved ground into the stretch but never menaced. NUTMEG NED outside foe early then gained stalking position from off the rail, dropped back around the final turn and was eased in the stretch. RISE OF LEGENDS in tight from between horses into first turn, chased three wide then outside foe, also gave way readily and was eased in the stretch.
