### Footnotes

MAJOR TRUTH pulled a bit behind the dueling leaders into the first turn, stalked in the clear down the backstretch, moved up around the second turn, reached even terms with PRIMED AND READY at the top of the stretch, took a short lead in mid-stretch and drew clear in the final furlong. PRIMED AND READY dueled for the lead three deep around the first turn and into the backstretch, inched away from his pace rivals at the quarter pole, could not match strides with the winner in mid-stretch but was clearly second best. PROUD BULL outrun into the first turn, was asked for run on the backstretch, angled towards the rail in the lane and passed tiring rivals. SONOFTOKAYANA was hustled out of the gate, dueled for the lead between horses around the first turn and into the backstretch, could not keep pace leaving the three eighths pole and weakened. OUR SMOKIN HERO dueled for the lead on the inside around the first turn and down the backstretch, began to fall back entering the second turn and weakened.
