Footnotes

LITTLE EMILY kept the pacesetter early company from off the rail through two turns, moved past that rival nearing three-eighths marker, kicked clear while roused into the stretch then dug in under strong handed urging and desperately lasted. GLOWING SPIRIT (BRZ) gained stalking position early while bit off the fence, stalked on two wide path, roused around the final, came three wide into the stretch then whittled gap on leader through the drive under vigorous handling only to narrowly miss from outside the winner. GOING FOR A SPIN settled inside then off the rail, chased either three wide or between horses, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. HARD TO RESIST unhurried from the inside, hugged the rail around first two turns, later came out some and two wide exiting the last turn but could not match outside rival for third. KAYCE ACE quickly stepped to the front, under pressure on the lead from along the rail around two turns, surrendered the lead nearing three-eighths marker and weakened inside. PLAZA DE INDIAS (CHI) settled outside rival, chased slightly off the rail then between horses, was in bit tight on the second turn, remained inside and lacked needed late punch. SWEET NOTHINGS settled outside, chased three wide then was outside eventual runner-up on final backstretch, caught four wide into last bend, dropped back around that bend and gave way late.
