STRIKING SPIRIT (GB) content to track leaders from off the rail into backstretch, moved up willingly and quickly grabbed control, moved clear and secured the inside, roused entering the stretch and disposed of outside rival then accelerated away under right hand urging and scored convincingly under long hold late. BRERETON PARK contested the early issue while outside rival around initial turn, was overtaken by winner nearing three-eighths marker, closed gap on that rival on second turn but could not go with winner in upper stretch and held second. DAVE'S PACEMAKER was off step slow, chased early from along the rail then two wide, raced three wide into the stretch and out battled inside rival for the show. TONIGHT AT ELEVEN settled off the rail, raced outside rival into and through the backstretch, came in slightly exiting the last turn and was outfinished for third. RAINGEAR chased three wide into first turn, was widest off all early on the backstretch, continued three then four wide on the last turn and into stretch and never threatened. HAMMURABI hooked up in early speed duel from along the rail into backstretch, had little resistance for winner, continued inside and weakened. NISUS angled over early, saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside and also weakened.
