JUST RULER content to lag back while two wide and along the rail, ignited rally passing three eighths marker, weaved through traffic around final turn, angled out under left hand urging, then collared leader and powered away. GREY MEMO unhurried while saving ground and inside the winner, came off the fence then regained rail on the final bend while moving up and finished willingly to prove next best. L'EFFACEUR quickly assumed command and set a quick pace, gained a breather in middle stages, responded and opened up around the final turn, but grew leg weary, drifted out and was collared. BUDROYALE settled off the leaders while saving ground, later angled out, raced three wide around the last bend and finished willingly from the outside. RED EYE chased the pacesetter from along the rail through two turns, advanced midway on final backstretch, loomed but could not sustain effort and weakened from the inside. INDIAHOMA angled in some early while tugging hard, then gained the rail near the second turn but never reached contention. FLYING RUDOLPH chased outside RED EYE through the early stages, moved up on the final backstretch but gave way readily over the final quarter.
