**Footnotes**

EXPLOITED DREAM attended the pace for a half mile, slipped through along the rail, came wider into the stretch and kicked clear. RELENTLESS raced in the middle of the pack to the backstretch, edged up while racing off the rail, came three wide through the final turn and was no match for the winner late. LEVITATE never far back, saved ground and rallied inside to just miss the place. WARREN'S CRYSTAL lagged for a half mile, rallied four wide and closed willingly without menacing the top ones. LAST GIRL STANDING dueled for a half mile, remained close, drifted out very wide turning for home and faltered. CALL ME TAYLOR raced in the middle of the pack throughout. BLONDEONTHERUN had no early speed and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. QUICK HONEY showed speed to the first turn, drifted out wide and gradually dropped back. KINGS MISTRESS rushed up to duel to the final turn, steadied and dropped back suddenly. LADY GOLD SLEW was off a step slow and was not a factor.
