Footnotes

LITECORR prompted the early issue while three wide, stalked on same path to final bend, whittled gap on leader under strong urging, reached the front and inched away. UR TURN DUBAI set or forced the pace while outside rival, edged away entering the stretch, dug in gamely from the inside but could not stave off the winner. LEGAL SEPARATION bumped with inside foe early, chased four then three wide, was outside same rival into second turn then closed gap on top pair late in game effort. ROCKY ICE bumped with outside rival early, chased three wide, angled in, found the rail and lacked needed response. ZAGORA'S PRIDE flashed good early foot along the rail, contested the pace to the second turn, dropped back bit and weakened inside late. SHERRY'S TOPPER four wide into first turn, came in bit leaving that bend, later secured the rail and lacked any rally. SIERRA SEVEN was off slow and bit inward, lagged back, saved ground throughout and failed to menace. HE'S A REBEL tucked in behind dueling leaders, stalked from the inside and also weakened.
