Footnotes

CHALULA ONE prominently placed into the backstretch and tracked pace from off the rail, rushed up and surged past rival early on the second turn, accelerated away while three wide into the stretch and comfortably held rivals at bay late while under strong urging. HALFAPONDAROSA unhurried from the inside, chased either along the rail or two wide, moved up some into the lane, between horses in upper stretch, then fought inside rival final sixteenth and won battle for the place. CAME WEST caught three deep into first turn, continued widest of all on the backstretch, remained on same path around final turn, battled outside rival in the lane and was outfinished for second. ENTABENI was antsy then bobbed slightly leaving the gate, forced the pace outside leader, gained brief lead into second bend, was just as quickly overtaken then weakened from the inside. ALL THE LOVE was off bit slow, between horses early, drifted out into first turn, chased from slightly off the fence and lacked any rally. JOE JA sped to the front, set pace from along the fence, relinquished command into second bend then gave way readily.
