Footnotes

ALL ON THE TABLE bumped by outside rival then bobbed in opening strides, tracked leaders from slightly off the rail, roused on the second turn, quickly whittled gap on leader, gained lead passing sixteenth marker and inched away. DELTA FIX pressured the pacesetter to the second turn, gained lead then edged away, came in exiting that bend, was quickly confronted by winner, briefly resisted and fought gamely to the finish. ITALIAN CHANNEL broke inward and bumped winner, bumped again with another rival entering the first turn, chased along the inside, came two wide into the stretch and was along for third. DESERT PARADISE settled off the rail, chased outside foe then three wide around the second turn and bested others. STICK TO THE PLAN drifted out entering the first turn, remained well off the rail leaving that bend and never recovered. FREE TIME broke alertly and sped to the front, set pressured pace from the inside, could not go with rival entering second turn and weakened inside. WALLEYE JOE bumped with rival into first turn, chased from between foes then inside, saved ground but was outrun.
