Footnotes

MARK'S CAT bumped leaving the gate but still sped to the front, stretched lead around the turn, drifted out under left hand pressure nearing sixteenth marker, then was straightened and clearly prevailed under steady handling. SURELYLU'S ANDANTE broke out and bumped the winner, forced the early issue from along the rail, lost contact around the turn, shifted out in the drive and was along late for the place. FLEW FLICKER tracked the pacesetter from between horses early, chased three wide into the stretch, came in slightly in the lane and lost second. GENERALLY OURS settled inside, shifted out leaving the backstretch, raced three wide exiting the turn then regained the rail in the stretch and finished willingly. VALLEY SPIRIT flashed brief early foot then settled off the pace, stalked from either between horses or two wide and lacked needed late punch. BAY GAMBLER was bit slow to begin, lagged back and chased from the inside while never threatening. FIRST CAT was off bit slow, chased outside rival, angled four wide entering the stretch and was outrun. MINE FEVER bobbled leaving the gate but quickly recovered, close up early from the outside, caught four wide into the bend and weakened.
